The savage deed (rape and beheading), thought to be committed by a mentally unbalanced person, leaves everyone horrified and united in prayer with the local population, visibly shaken by the atrocity committed against religious who, with great generosity and self-renunciation, had been working for years among them.

The Daughters of St. Paul want to express their closeness to the Xaverian Sisters in this time of profound grieving, asking the God of life to grant eternal rest to the sisters killed and to enlighten the person who committed this heinous crime.
